The regional FENS meeting in Pécs will focus on the most recent discoveries in neuroscience from molecules to behaviour, highlighting discoveries of translational potential. In addition to the wide range of scientific insights a special emphasis will be placed on cutting-edge technologies. The conference will be held for four days and will include six plenary speaker sessions, numerous symposia and poster sessions.

Pécs, the Mediterranean city of Hungary, is located in the South of Hungary. It can be easily reached by train or long distance bus service from Budapest. The Kodály Centre is situated within 10 minutes walking from the city centre.
